Joseph Perrier Cuvée Royale Brut Champagne, France [Bin 1]

From one of the great overachieving, underestimated small Champagne houses, this wine has a relaxed, easy-drinking style with a warm brioche weight to support its fresh apple fruit. (1) Vegan

Joseph Perrier Cuvée Royale Rosé Brut Champagne, France [Bin 2]

With a pinkish terracotta colour, this is a light, welcoming rosé with an abundant mousse and plenty of vibrant strawberry and violet flavours for a delicate perfumed style. (1) Vegan

Superb and confident with a rich, biscuity character and a lingering finish. A classic vintage Champagne. (1)

Melons and peaches are suggested in this soft Southern wine: its lifted bouquet and supple flavour are quietly sensual. (2) Vegetarian

Vitis Nostra Primitivo, Italy [Bin 19]

Delicately balanced between sweetness and acidity. A fragrant wine of red fruits with hints of ripe cherry and a sweet finish. (3) Vegetarian

Vieille Monnaie Pinot Noir, France [Bin 20]

Fuller than Pinot Noir from Burgundy, it has a warm, rich nose with aromas of dark wild cherry and just a hint of toasty oak. The palate is nicely balanced with an exciting, savoury bitterness provided by ripe, tasty tannins. (2)

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Hero Wines - White

Vignerons de Terres Secretes Pouilly Fuissé, Burgundy, France [Bin 34]

A well-balanced delicate but powerful wine with aromatic complexity and good ageing potential. Fine aromas of white flowers and citrus fruit which later evolve into notes of hazelnut, butter, vanilla and toast. (2) Vegan

Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand [Bin 35]

This iconic wine is reminiscent of fresh fruit salad - full of peach, mango, cut through with a citrus whiplash. (2)

Saint-Aubin 1er Cru Les Murgers des Dents de Chien, Gerard Thomas et Filles, Burgundy, France [Bin 41]

A concentrated palate revealing notes of honey, dried peach and spice. It has refined crisp acidity that suffuses the palate with minerality as it rolls out on the finish. (2) Vegetarian

Floral and almond notes on the nose, vanilla on the palate. Very neat and confident Puligny with signs of balanced ageing for added depth. (2) Vegetarian

Whispering Angel, Provence, France [Bin 14]

Pale pink in colour, it has flavours of redcurrant, dried flowers and spices on the nose, with a subtle herbal quality. Dry, with bitter red fruit flavours, it has a firm finish with lingering herbal notes. (1)

Hero Wines – Red

Cossetti Barolo, Italy [Bin 46]

A long-aged wine of great class. Garnet red with orange reflections that intensify over time. Intense aroma of red and purple fruits, the flavour is full and velvety, with a spicy finish. (5)

Château Potensac, Bordeaux, France [Bin 67]

Classic notes of red and blackcurrants, earth and spice are well-presented in this deep ruby/purple coloured, medium-bodied wine, which should drink nicely for a decade or more. (3)

Chateau Musar, Lebanon [Bin 68]

Blood red in colour with a rich, fragrant fruit nose: mulberries, black cherries, plums with a hint of mocha. The palate is very intense and concentrated, it's full of volume and characterised by forest and black fruits with elegant spice. The tannins are soft and juicy with a lengthy finish. (4) Vegan

Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Colombo & Fille, France [Bin 69]

A big wine intense colour, nose and palate. Ripe fruit and gingerbread spice with herbaceous notes. (3)

A young and juicy Pinot Noir with an abundance of red berries and a touch of violet on the palate. Very smooth and well-structured with a youthful ripe aroma. (3) Vegetarian

Sharpham Dart Valley Reserve, England [Bin 21]

Super full-flavoured, tropical fruits, guava with a delicate spice, good concentration and high acidity, a zippy estate wine. Energetic and with all the structure for a long and happy life. (2) Vegan

Cool and grassy, with a boisterous touch of gooseberry fruit over a neat mineral base, this offers classic character at good value. (1) Vegan

Elegantly balanced aromas of citrus, green melon and white blossom. The palate is silky, with mouth-watering green apple, citrus and stone minerals that lead to a long and refreshing finish. (1)

Leaps out of its skin with zesty lemon tropical freshness followed on by more rounded melon flavours. (3) Vegan

Just what a good young Muscadet is all about. A suggestion of sea breeze over new-mown hay, some mineral cool, finished with calm length. (1) Vegan

With its floral bouquet, apple fruit and cool acid balance, all Vouvray's key features are on show here. Its medium-dry softness makes a delightful apéritif. (3) Vegan

The peach-scented Viognier is perfectly pitched. Skillful winemaking keeps the peach notes true, right through the lovely, long, cool finish. (1) Vegetarian

Bright favourite from the Latour stable, with fresh grassy notes, plenty of tropical fruit and a firm roundness. Good ripe Chardonnay, with a touch of age. (2) Vegetarian

Esk Valley Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand [Bin 31]

Very lean and grassy with a mineral, citrus zing. It has an added complexity of asparagus pungency and bright nettley notes. Absolutely classic benchmark Sauvignon. (1) Vegan

Fincas de Azabache Tempranillo Blanco, Spain [Bin 32]

This is a real find. White Tempranillo is a 'new' grape variety but closely linked to the well-known red Tempranillo grown all over Spain. This style is robust yet unoaked, with apple refreshment and elegantly balanced. (1) Vegan

Grand'Arte Alvarinho, Portugal [Bin 33]

Real finesse with an intense aroma of ripe orchard fruits. The body is full with a delicious, creamy tropical character yet has a fresh, citrus quality and a long finish. (2) Vegan

Deen Vat 7 Chardonnay, De Bortoli, Australia [Bin 36]

Golden Aussie Chardonnay shows a touch of caramel and vanilla oak, with plenty of up-front spice and nicely structured fruit. Full of ripe flavours, balanced with a racy citrus line. (2) Vegan

Agustinos Estate Pinot Gris, Chile [Bin 37]

A delicious example of this popular grape variety (more commonly seen as Pinot Grigio). Aromas of fresh red apple and ripe quince fruit. The palate is fresh and balanced. (2) Vegan

Michel Leon Gewürztraminer, France [Bin 38]

Golden in colour and full of floral, spicy aromas as you would expect from this most aromatic varietal. Supple, balanced and pleasantly long on the palate. (2)

A Medium-bodied fruity Riesling with nicely balanced acidity and flavours of peaches, with a hint of apricot. (2)

A very fruity aroma with sweet overtones resulting from good quality Viura grapes. Well structured, good acidity and a long finish. From an excellent family producer. (2) Vegetarian

Vita Sangiovese, Italy [Bin 44]

Red wine with some classic Sangiovese character: crisp cherry and raspberry fruit with ripe tannins and a wave of refreshing acidity on the finish. (3) Vegetarian

Valpolicella Superiore Ripasso, Zonin, Italy [Bin 45]

A wonderfully rich and complex deep ruby-red wine with intense aromas of cherries and chocolate. Dry and robust on the palate with a fine and harmonious balance. (5)

Morgon Les Corcelettes, Louis Latour, France [Bin 47]

Morgon is the most dense and long-lived Cru of Beaujolais. Full-bodied, firm and able to age. (4) Vegetarian

Cormoran Crianza, Spain [Bin 48]

Dark cherry red. Clean with intense ripe fruit, liquorice and toasted notes. This wine is rich and rounded in the mouth with a lovely long finish. (3) Vegan

Casa Vinironia Appassimento, Italy [Bin 49]

A full-bodied soft wine giving characteristic notes of ripe plum and raisins. Oak ageing adds to the intensity with pleasing notes of spice and vanilla. (4) Vegan

Huntersville Pinotage, South Africa [Bin 50]

A superb young Pinotage. The flavours of this unique South African cultivar show ripe plum and fruitcake all beautifully integrated and then finished with subtle oak for a lingering aftertaste. (3) Vegan

Frunza Pinot Noir, Romania [Bin 51]

Flavours of cherry, raspberry and plums. This Pinot Noir has a balanced acidity, medium-body and slightly spicy finish. (1) Vegan

Cave des Grands Vins de Fleurie, France [Bin 52]

Notes of slightly tart blackberries give this wine a nice balance. On the palate, the powerful, smooth tannins reinforce the succulent character of this Fleurie, which delivers a lovely, long-lingering finish. (2) Vegan

Ermita de San Felices Reserva, Spain [Bin 53]

Intensely concentrated with blackberry fruit and wonderful enriching sweetness. Beginning to show meaty, gamey, leathery development with a finish that lasts forever. Fabulous! (4) Vegetarian

Hahn Winery Pinot Noir, USA [Bin 54]

This wine's bouquet charms with scents of red cherry, ripe strawberry, cola and spice. On the palate, soft mouthfeel complements flavours recalling plums and black cherry. Supple tannins and a dash of acidity end in a beautifully balanced, clean finish. (3) Vegan

Trueno Malbec, Argentina [Bin 55]

Ruby red with notes of raisins, chocolate, coffee, tobacco and caramel. Smooth and well-balanced, purity of red and blackberry fruits and a lingering finish. (4) Vegan

Estate Collection Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva, Viu Manent, Chile [Bin 56]

Fresh red berries and blackcurrants on the nose with subtle notes of vanilla. Soft tannins lead to a long finish. (4) Vegan

Made by Spain's first female Master of Wine. A deep ruby red. Intense juicy red fruits on the nose which explode in the mouth then melt into forest fruits, and well-integrated tannin. A hint of toasted oak and sumptuous texture.

Paxton Pollinator Shiraz, Australia [Bin 58]

A vibrant and fresh unoaked lively Shiraz. Plum and red berry fruit aromas entice on the nose and the palate delivers a vibrant mouthfeel, balanced with integrated tannins on the finish. All natural, biodynamic, organic and no added preservatives. (3) Vegan

Secret Carménère, Viu Manent, Chile [Bin 59]

This Carménère's has a typical spicy character with aromas of black pepper, fruits, berries, and a subtle note of fresh-ground coffee. The medium-bodied palate presents good volume, balance, and a smooth texture that leads to a very pleasing finish. (3) Vegan

Château Sergant, Lalande-de-Pomerol, France [Bin 60]

This 12-month oak-aged wine has power and structure. On the nose, fresh notes of raspberries and blackberry jam are followed by vanilla and spice. A great length and depth of flavour takes over and hints of chocolate, smoke and caramel offer a lovely savoury nature. (3)

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Dessert Wines

Deen Vat 5 Botrytis Semillon, De Bortoli Half, Australia [Bin 63]

De Bortoli Vat 5 is a perfect expression of botrytis: pure luminescent gold in colour, with intense marmalade and dried peel fruit flavours, plus the botrytis honeyed effect. (5) Vegetarian

Campbells Rutherglen Muscat Half, Australia [Bin 64]

Bright amber gold with copper tints. Intense Muscat aroma and fresh raisin fruit backed by a hint of fortifying spirit and aged oak characters. Lusciously sweet. (5)

Château Petit Vedrines, France [Bin 66]

Classic peach and honey notes characterise this wine. The perception of sweetness is offset by fruit, dried apricot and melon. (4) Vegan
