47 **Stag's Leap Wine Cellars Karia Chardonnay** | 96 California, USA

A monumental Chardonnay from a monumental producer. Sets the scene with rich notions of pineapple, banana custard, melon and toast. It's rich, opulent and mouthfilling with a toasty, tropical finish.

Stag's Leap is one of the undisputed icons of the Napa Valley. The winery was founded in 1970, and their 1973 Cabernet won the famous Judgement of Paris tasting, beating first- and second-growth bordeaux. Since then they have become one of the most lauded and sought-after wine producers anywhere in the world.

48 **Pouilly-Fuissé Vielle Vignes, Rijckaert** | 110 Burgundy, France

A fine and intense nose combining zesty lemon, freshly baked patisserie and fleshy white fruits, the structure is round but with a strong mineral tension and orchard fruit compote flavours.

Vins Rijckaert was founded in 1998 by passionate Flemish winemaker Jean Rijckaert. He established his own domaine with four hectares in the Mâconnais as well as five hectares in the Jura, making him the first person to produce wines simultaneously in both regions. In 2013 Jean met his alter ego Florent Rouve, a fellow winemaker who became Jean's protégé. Gradually he passed on his savoir-faire and philosophy to Florent, and eventually transferred the business itself. Florent has continued to develop the style of Vins Rijckaert wines with his own signature, balancing their natural richness with great freshness and precision.

49 **Puligny-Montrachet Les Corvees, Bernard Millot** | 160 Côte de Beaune, France

From the Les Corvées vineyard in Puligny-Montrachet, this elegant wine shows vibrant flavours of green apple, lemon zest, and white peach, with hints of toasted almond, vanilla.

5th generation estate Bernard Millot is a small (eight hectare) domaine based in Meursault. Since 2010 Bernard's son Emilien has been crafting beautiful wines with a deep respect for the natural environment and a delicate hands-on approach to viticulture and winemaking. Emilien's wines are restrained and textural with modest use of new oak allowing the fruit to shine.

VILLA ANTINORI

50 **Villa Antinori Chianti Classico Riserva** | 67 Tuscany, Italy

This is a rich, modern Chianti that marries beautifully ripe cherry fruit with well-judged smoky oak notes. The opulence on the palate is tempered by savoury notes of clove and a firm structure supporting the plump fruit.

For almost a century of history, Villa Antinori has represented the concept of home, home territory and Tuscany in a contemporary style. Villa Antinori envisions wine production with experimentation and development on one side and historical values on the other.

RIDGE VINEYARDS

51 **Ridge Three Valleys** | 90 California, USA

Ripe red fruits on the nose. The medium-full palate is layered with flavours of plums, wild berries, savoury herbs and black olives, with just enough tannin to add a pleasing grip.

One of the best-loved names in American wine. Thanks to the thoughtful and consistent application of simple principles: carefully chosen, mature vineyards farmed with great care; minimum-intervention winemaking; production decisions guided by continual blind tasting; and total transparency through ingredient labelling. Ridge has joined the ranks of the timeless classics.

Prunotto

52 **Barolo, Prunotto** | 100 Piedmont, Italy

Complex nose with notes of rose, strawberry and forest fruits. Delicately floral, yet persistent on the palate, this is Barolo at its best.

The Prunotto estate is located in Alba, the most important city in the Langhe area halfway between Barbaresco and Barolo. Prunotto reveals its territory's rich heritage and unique attributes in each bottle capturing the different expressions that each vineyard parcel reflects.

MASI®

53 **Riserva Costasera Amarone Classico, Masi** | 120 Veneto, Italy

Plums and baked cherries on the nose with hints of bay leaf. Magnificently rich and soft on the palate with cherry, blueberry and sweet spice flavours. Long, dry finish with a touch of fresh blueberry.

In 2022, Masi celebrated the 250th anniversary of the Boscaini family's first harvest in the Vaio di Masi, and what a history it is. As dedicated to research as they are to winemaking. They are the leading Amarone producer, instrumental in the development of this extraordinary style, made solely from semi-dried grapes. In the late 1950s, they identified certain historic plots which are vinified as Amarone and bottled separately to this day. In 1964, they launched the now-legendary Campofiorin, which revived the technique of a second fermentation with semi-dried grapes, adding depth and complexity to Valpolicella.

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| 22 | Dog Point Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough (Organic)
South Island, New Zealand   | 52 |
| <p>Classic citrus and crisp apple aromas, with some gentle tropical undertones on the nose. The palate combines fresh citrus and lemon peel, with a saline acidity and a subtle smokiness on the finish.</p> <p><i>First planted, in 1979, by Ivan and Margaret Sutherland, Dog Point's icon status has been maintained through a meticulous approach in both the vineyard and the winery. Now the responsibility of the next generation of the Sutherland family, all the grapes from the low-cropped, organic vineyard are hand-picked and the wines are either partially or fully fermented with wild yeasts. Dog Point Vineyard is New Zealand's largest certified organic vineyard, by Biogro NZ. The name Dog Point dates back to the earliest European settlement of Marlborough and the introduction of sheep, and sheep dogs, to the district.</i></p> | | |

Veneto, Italy 
 Attractive, aromatic nose dominated by cherries and spice. Well-balanced, full-bodied palate with notes of ripe red fruit, cherry liqueur and blueberries. Long aftertaste with hints of vanilla and cocoa.
- 39 **Brouilly - Domaine de Martingale, Duboeuf** | 51
Beaujolais, France 
 Produced from grapes grown at the foot of Mont Brouilly this delicious wine displays Intense aromas of red and black fruits. Well balanced and full-bodied, with fine and elegant tanins. .

- 40 **Valley Floor Shiraz, Langmeil** | 55
South Australia, Australia 
 The 'Valley Floor', like other premium wines of the Barossa, is a regional blended wine. Grapes are sourced from specially selected vineyards across all the sub regions of the Barossa from a range of 120, 70, 50 year old and younger select parcels of which are then open fermented and basket pressed to make this classic example of honest, hand made Barossa Valley Shiraz.
- The Lindner family has been immersed in the Barossa's culture of farming, food and wine for six generations, and their Langmeil winery is a model of the family-run producer. James Lindner is in charge of sales and marketing, while his brother Paul is chief winemaker. The commitment to quality in all aspects is unwavering, the wines showing the assurance and deft touch that only ever come from intimate knowledge of the region. Langmeil is also home to what is believed to be the oldest surviving Shiraz vineyard in the world.*



- 41 **Château Vieille Tour La Rose, Saint-Emilion GC** | 64
Bordeaux, France 
 Adorned with a sumptuous deep burgundy colour, this wine releases aromas of intense black fruits, a light woodiness and vanilla nuances. This palette of beautiful complexity is found on the palate. The round mouthfeel is full-bodied and offers a smooth attack. It opens with aromas of fresh fruit relayed by promising tannins. A beautiful vintage, produced with passion on this black Merlot vineyard, which reflects the quality of the work in the vineyard and in the cellar.
